To apply for or to take **Test of English Proficiency**, the prerequisite for BEI Basic, an applicant must

- be at least 18 years old;
- have earned a high school diploma or its equivalent; and
- <u>earned at least 30 credit hours from an accredited college</u> or university, with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- not have a criminal conviction that could qualify as grounds for denial, probation, suspension, or revocation of a BEI certificate, or other disciplinary action against any holder of a BEI certificate. To take the **BEI Basic performance test**, an applicant must have

- met all the criteria above AND
- earned a passing score on the Test of English Proficiency
- **earned an associate degree and/or a minimum of 60 credit hours** from an accredited college or university, with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- earn a passing score on the performance exam.

## To maintain certification:

- Interpreter must not have a criminal conviction that could qualify as grounds for denial, probation, suspension, or revocation of a BEI certificate, or other disciplinary action against any holder of a BEI certificate

- Every 5 years complete 100 hours of Continuing Education Units Including:
  - 6.0 CEUs (60 clock hours) in interpreting-related topics;
  - 2.0 CEUs (20 clock hours) in ethics-related topics; and
  - 2.0 CEUs (20 clock hours) in general studies.
